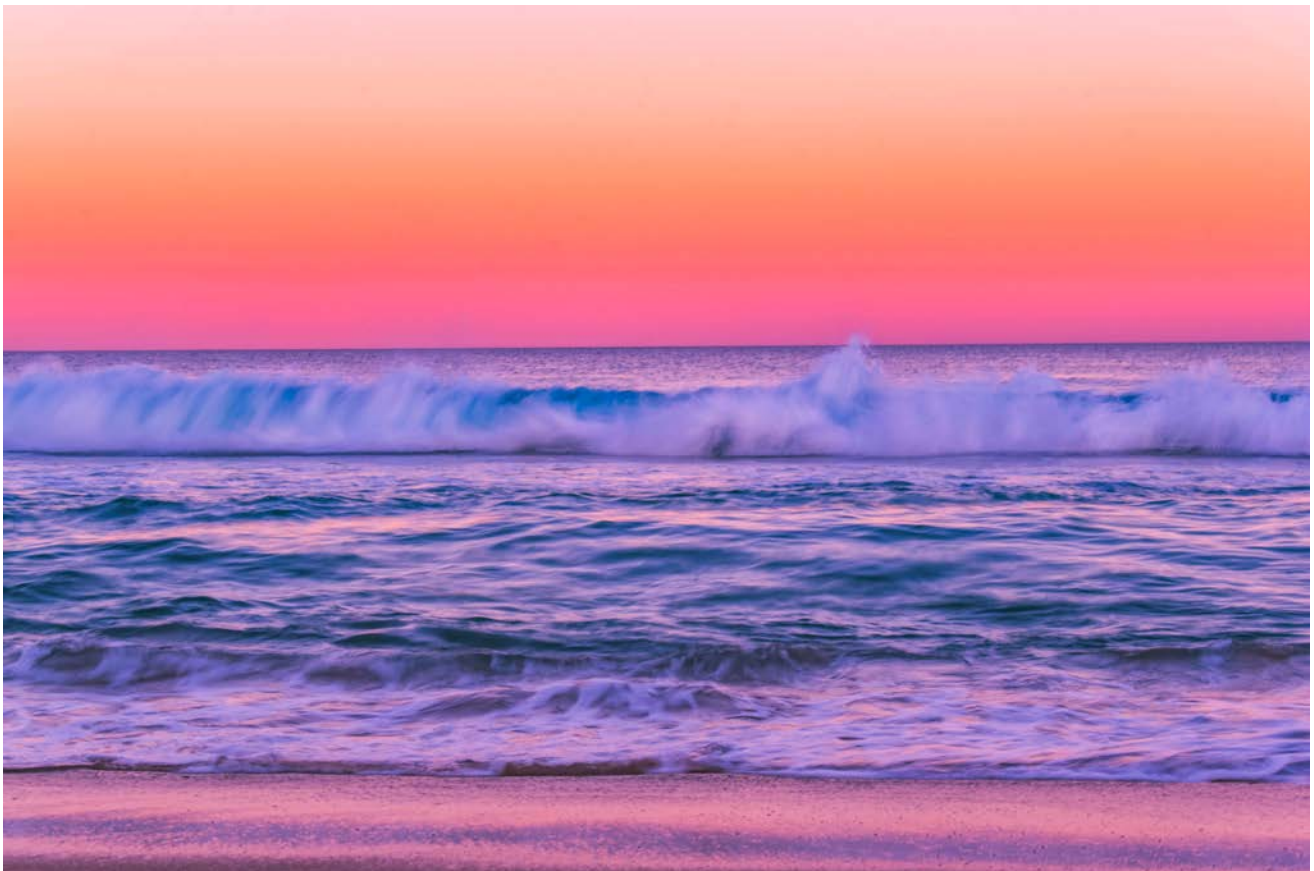


# Pride Month

# Dad Jokes

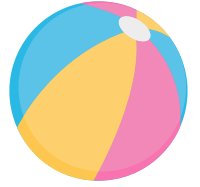


Here are some dad jokes for Father's Day!
